Rain Forces Open Co-Champs; A Continues, 23-Under Starts



As the Open Championship game between Circle Tap and Townline began Thursday evening at Sunset Park, rain began to fall.

Three and a half innings into the contest, the game was called due to heavier rains that continued well into the evening.

The only previous time that co-champions were named at the NAFA World Series was during the first-ever NAFA World Series in Crystal Lake, Illinois.

Co-champions were named in the AAA and AA Central Zone (NAFA had three zones of play in the AA division).

Townline's Tane Richardson was named the Most Valuable Player, teammate Aaron Neemia the Outstanding Offensive Player and Colin McKenzie of Circle Tap the Most Valuable Pitcher.

Circle Tap was also given the Sportsmanship Awards.

Action in Class A continues today at both Memorial Park and Sunset Park, with the final round of games being rescheduled to 7am this morning.

This evening also marks the start of the 23-and-Under Division.

Last year in North Mankato, LeMay's Humphrey Street Grill of Lake Crystal became the first ever NAFA 23-and-Under World Champions by defeating the Kegel Black Knights.

A new champion will be crowned this year as 8 teams will vie for the Championship. Teams will play two seeding play games tonight.

They will then be seeded into a double-elimination bracket, which begins play tomorrow. The Championship is scheduled for Sunday.
