# **Cerro Gordo Wins A-Major; AA Champion Crowned Today**



The first champion of the 2006 NAFA World Series was named yesterday when Cerro Gordo of Dawson, Minnesota defeated Village Inn 6-1 to win the A-Major championship.

Cerro Gordo went undefeated with a 6-0 record on the weekend.
